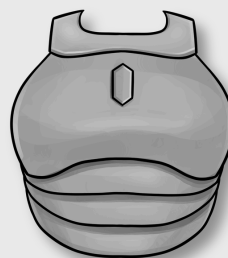
Legacy Mandalorians are perhaps the most ornate Mandalorians that can be found within the Modern Era. This style reflects the regalness of its wearer with elegant but dangerously layered armor plates. They rule the battlefield and garner respect with their demanding and well put together presence.

CHEST ARMOR

- Consists of a collar plate, chest plates, chest diamond, and ab plate. Custom styles are allowed.
- Must not have gaps between overlapping collar, chest, chest diamond, and abdomen.
- Shoulder armor can be custom or Fett style. Arc trooper-style shoulder pauldrons are allowed in conjunction with regular shoulders but not in lieu of.

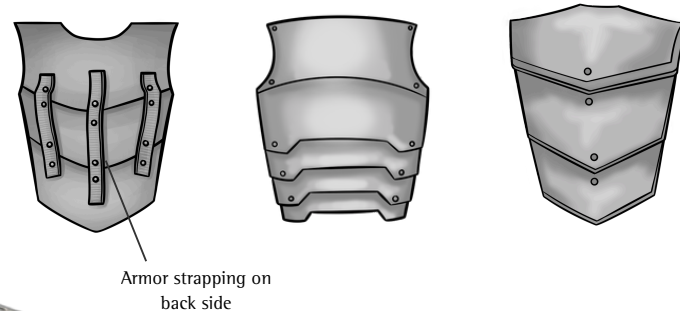
HELMET LIST

HELMET

- Custom Modern and some Post-Imperial style helmets.
- At least 2/3 of T-Visor must be visible. "T" shape required.

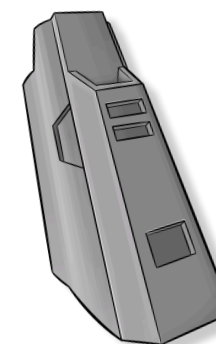
BACK COVERING

- A hard backplate or other armored cover, such as a hard backpack, jetpack, air tank, etc. is required that covers 2/3 the overall width and length of the back.
- Back armor must not have any gaps between plates.
- Capes, dusters, jetpacks, and hard backpacks can be used in lieu of an armored back covering if they fully conceal the lack of a backplate.



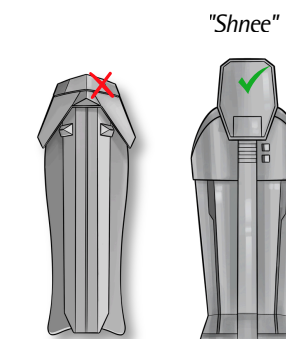
GAUNTLETS

- Armor or rigid covering on the forearms. Including, but not limited to: Gauntlets, hard bracers, or armored gloves.



LOWER BODY

- Both knees and a cod piece are the minimum.
- Soft cod or a loincloth can be used instead of a hard cod piece.
- "Shnees" (knee + shin combo) are an acceptable variant for knees.



To be approvable as a shnee, the additional knee piece must cover most of the knee cap



SOFT PARTS

FLAK VEST & FLIGHT SUIT

- Vests may be traditional Fett style or custom style. (Shoulder caps are optional.)
- Short-sleeved flight suits are allowed (ends no shorter than mid bicep).

BELT & AMMO POUCHES

- Must have two of the following:
 - 1) Ammo or holster belt
 - 2) Girth belt or waist sash

OTHER SOFT PARTS

- Full fingered or fingerless gloves.
- Dusters, capes, and ponchos may be worn in lieu of a backplate.
- Kamas can be worn, but are not required.
